### **ENTRY FORM INSTRUCTIONS**

Register no later than September 1, 2019 by sending <u>one entry form per item</u> to: **Jeanne Baumann, 322 Eagles Nest Rd, Marquette MI 49855**. Enter as many items as you wish. All items entered must remain until the show closes at 4:00 PM on Sunday, October 20. Pick-up quilts from 4:30 PM – 5:30 PM on Sunday, October 20.

**Please read all information carefully**. Fill out <u>all</u> sections of the entry form. <u>Use one form for each item entered</u>. Please make copies of the form for additional entries. Updated information and additional forms are available from MCQA website at <a href="https://www.marguettequilters.org">www.marguettequilters.org</a>.

**Optional judging is available for the categories marked with a** \* Be sure to check the box on the entry form if you want the guilt judged.

**Categories for entries are shown on Page #4.** Remember judging is optional only in the categories marked with an \*.

On the back of the form page 1, please provide interesting information about your quilt. You might include such things as, what inspired you to make it, some history of the quilt, if it is for someone special, how you felt making it, batting or material used or anything else you want people to know about your quilt. Try to evoke an emotion in your description. What you write will appear on the hang tag at the show and in the booklet. (50 words or less)\* Your description may be edited for clarity or space.

**Securely attach QUILT IDENTIFICATION TAG** (provided on page 2) to the lower right hand corner of the **backside** of the quilt with safety pins or basting before the item is entered in the show. Fold the tag so your name is hidden, and fasten on three sides as shown. Please bring your quilt folded with the tag facing out and on top.

Photograph your quilt for insurance purposes before submitting.

### **Quilt Drop Off Options:**

- Bring entries to the Great Lakes Rooms, University Center, NMU, Marquette, MI on Thursday, Oct.17, between 7:30 AM and 1:00 PM.
- Mail your quilt to Chris Swenor, 817 W. College Ave, Marquette MI 49855. Always insure your quilt adequately. UPS suggests quilts be sealed in plastic inside the mailing carton. Enclose a SASE for confirmation of arrival. Include return postage and insurances with your item(s) if it is to be returned by US mail or UPS. We must receive the item by Tuesday, October 15, 2019.
- As a last resort, you may drop your quilt off at the home of Chris Swenor by calling 906-226-6707. You must drop off the item by 5:00 pm Tuesday, October 15, 2019.

Pick-up after the show is between 4:30 and 5:30 PM. You must have your PICK-UP RECEIPT. Do not remove your item(s) at closing time without going through the check-out process. NO EXCEPTIONS, PLEASE!

**24 hour security is provided**. Quilts will be hung with clips and a 'white glove patrol' will prevent handling by the public. We reserve the right to display items in the most appropriate manner. Only finished items will be displayed.

#### **AUTUMN COMFORTS 2019 QUILT SHOW CATEGORIES**

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> You may choose to have your quilts judged in any of the categories that are marked with a \* however you must be the maker of the quilt to have it judged. The decision of the judges is final. The judges have the discretion to award ribbons in categories where there are few entries. Please read the categories carefully before entering. If you have a question regarding the category for your quilt, please contact us for assistance.

★Appliqué, Hand	Any quilt using hand appliqué as the predominant technique. May be hand or machine pieced.
★Appliqué, Machine	Any quilt using machine appliqué as the predominant technique.
★Art Quilt, Mixed Media	A quilt featuring a non-original design based on a pattern or kit incorporating a combination of mixed media techniques.
★Art Quilt, Original	An original design quilt, designed by the maker using any combination of techniques.
Bed Turning	Quilts will be stacked on a bed. As each quilt is turned down a narration will be read including a description and story of the quilt.  Antique and vintage quilts can be included in this category.
★Embroidered, Hand	Any quilt that is predominantly hand embroidered.
★Embroidered, Machine	Any quilt that is predominantly machine embroidered.

Gwinn Quilters exhibit	For Gwinn Quilters members only
Judges exhibit	Quilts made by Autumn Comforts judges
MCQA Challenge 2018 exhibit	For MCQA members only, Medallion Quilts

MCQA Charity exhibit	Quilts and items made for donation.

★Miniature Quilt	Any quilt no larger than 24 inches on any side, overall pattern reflecting proportionately reduced scale and/or individual blocks no larger than 3 inches square.
Quilt related item	Any item such as totes, bags, home accessories, clothing, etc
★Pieced, Small	Any pieced quilt based on traditional or modern patterns, done by hand or machine or combination, with a perimeter less than 234 inches.
★Pieced, Medium	Any pieced quilt based on traditional or modern patterns, done by hand or machine or combination, with a perimeter 234 inches to 368 inches.
★Pieced, Large	Any pieced quilt based on traditional or modern patterns, done by hand or machine or combination, with a perimeter greater than 368 inches.
★Whole Cloth	Quilts of any size with the predominant emphasis on the quality of quilting stitches and quilting pattern. Solid or printed fabric top may contain joining seams, absent of pieced blocks and borders.
