All items entered must remain until the show closes at 4:00 PM on Sunday, October 22nd. Pick-up quilts from 4:30 PM – 5:30 PM on Sunday, October 22nd.

- Please read all information carefully. Fill out <u>all</u> sections of the entry form. <u>Use one form for each item entered</u>. Please make copies of the form for additional entries. Updated information and additional forms are available from MCQA website at <u>www.marquettequilters.com</u>.
- Optional judging is available for all categories marked with a *. Be sure to put a check mark in one of the **boxes** in the upper corners of the form to show whether or not you want the quilt judged.
- Categories for all entries are shown on Page #2 of this form. Remember judging is optional only in the categories marked with an *.
- On the back of the form please provide interesting information about your quilt. You might include such things as, what inspired you to make it, some history of the quilt, if it is for someone special, how you felt making it, batting or material used or anything else you want people to know about your quilt. The decision of the judges is final. The judges have the discretion to award ribbons in categories where there are few entries. Please read the categories carefully before entering. If you have a question regarding the category for your quilt, please contact us for assistance.

CATEGORY NAME AND DEFINITION	
★ Categories with Optional judging	
★ MINIATURE QUILT – Any quilt measuring less than 24 inches on any side, overall pattern reflecting proportionately reduced scale and/or individual blocks no larger than 3 inch square.	
★ HAND APPLIQUE QUILT – Any quilt using hand appliqué as the predominant construction technique. Top may be hand or machine pieced. Top completely constructed by one person.	
MACHINE APPLIQUE QUILT – Any quilt using machine appliqué as the <u>predominant</u> construction technique.	
★ SMALL PIECED QUILT – Any quilt that is <u>predominantly</u> pieced based on traditional or modern patterns. Work may be done by hand or machine or a combination. <u>Maximum size</u> : Smaller than – or equal to - 240" total perimeter.	
★ LARGE PIECED QUILT – Any quilt that is predominantly pieced based on traditional or modern patterns. Work may be done by hand or machine or a combination. <u>Minimum size</u> : Greater than 240" total perimeter.	
★ MIXED TECHNIQUES QUILT – Any quilt that <u>predominantly</u> exhibits innovation in design and/or construction techniques. It includes mixed techniques as long as one of the techniques is non-traditional (such as but not limited to: fused appliqué, painting, embellishments, thread painting, thread techniques or other surface design elements).	
★ ORIGINAL DESIGN/ARTQUILT – Any original quilt completely designed and made by only one person. Traditional blocks and quilting may be incorporated into the design however, the quilt should <u>predominantly</u> be made with innovative design and techniques.	
★ HAND EMBROIDERED QUILT – Any quilt which is predominantly hand embroidered.	
★ MACHINE EMBROIDERED QUILT- Any quilt which is predominantly machine embroidered.	
★ WHOLE CLOTH QUILT- Any whole cloth quilt of any size. This includes whole cloth with trapunto.	
QUILT RELATED ITEMS – Any item such as totes, bags, home accessories, clothing, etc.	
BED TURNING - Quilts will be stacked on a bed. As each quilt is turned down a narration will be read including a description and story of the quilt. Antique and vintage quilts can be included in this category.	
MCQA GUILD CHALLENGE QUILT -SOUL OF SUPERIOR- This category is for MCQA members. Challenge quilts are to have a perimeter no larger than 160". All challenge quilts will be judged.
